PROGRAMS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

KENNEDY-LUGAR YOUTH EXCHANGE AND STUDY (YES)

The YES program provides scholarships for high school students (ages 15-17) to spend one academic year in the U.S. studying, living with host families, and acquiring leadership skills.

TECHGIRLS PROGRAM

TechGirls inspires girls to pursue higher education and careers in technology through a three week, U.S.-based program focused on hands-on skills development including programming, robotics, mobile application building, web design, video graphics, and 3D game design.

MEPI - TOMORROW'S LEADERS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Tomorrow's Leaders provides four-year university scholarships and internship opportunities at select institutions of higher learning in Lebanon to senior high school students who have the potential to become leaders. This program intends to nurture leadership skills and the spirit of civic engagement and volunteerism among outstanding university-age students at the American University of Beirut and the Lebanese American University.

PROGRAMS FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

THOMAS JEFFERSON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (TJSP)

TJSP UGRAD scholarships allow undergraduate students to pursue a year of non-degree study at U.S. universities. The TJSP Community College Scholarship Program builds the workforce capacity of ISET, ISSAT, and IHET students through a year of non-degree study at U.S. community colleges.

STUDY OF THE U.S. INSTITUTES (SUSI) FOR STUDENT LEADERS PROGRAMS

SUSIs for Student Leaders are five to six week intensive academic programs for undergraduate leaders focused on specific themes such as:

- Entrepreneurship and Economic Development
- Women's Leadership
- Youth, Education, and Closing the Skills Gap.

MEPI - STUDENT LEADERS PROGRAM

The Student Leaders program is an intensive five-week exchange in the U.S. for undergraduates and graduates (20-24) to develop leadership skills and expand their understanding of civil society and the democratic process.

ONE BEAT

OneBeat is a month-long international music exchange in the U.S. that celebrates musical collaboration and social engagement.

PROGRAMS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS & PROFESSIONALS

• FULBRIGHT FOREIGN STUDENT PROGRAM (M.A./Ph.D. Study)

The Fulbright M.A. program provides a maximum of two years of funding for a master's degree at a U.S. university. The PhD program enables graduate-level students enrolled in doctoral programs to conduct research in U.S. institutions for up to one academic year.

FULBRIGHT VISITING SCHOLAR PROGRAM /

This program offers scholarships to doctoral degree holders to conduct post-doctoral research and/or give lectures at U.S. universities for three to ten months.

FULBRIGHT SPECIALIST PROGRAM

The Fulbright Specialist Program offers non-U.S. institutions the opportunity to host American academics or professionals to build expertise in a specific area.

FULBRIGHT FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING ASSISTANT PROGRAM (FLTA)

The FLTA places recent college graduates and young professionals (usually English teachers) as Arabic teaching assistants in American schools or universities for one academic year. FLTAs also pursue individual study and research.

STUDY OF THE U.S. INSTITUTES (SUSIS) FOR SCHOLARS AND SECONDARY EDUCATORS

SUSIs for Scholars and Secondary Educators are four to six week programs focused on improving curricula and teaching about the U.S. for university faculty and secondary school educators.

HUBERT H. HUMPHREY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The Humphrey Program brings young and mid-career professionals to the U.S. for a year of non-degree graduate-level study, leadership development, and professional collaboration with U.S. counterparts.

TECHWOMEN PROGRAM

TechWomen brings emerging women leaders in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) together with their professional counterparts in the U.S. for a five week mentorship and exchange program.

FULBRIGHT TEACHING EXCELLENCE AND ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM (TEA)

Fulbright TEA brings secondary school teachers of English as a Foreign Language, social studies, math, or science to the U.S. for a six week professional development program.

PROFESSIONAL FELLOWS PROGRAM (PFP)

The PFP brings emerging leaders to the U.S. for month-long intensive fellowships in public and private organizations.

COMMUNITY SOLUTIONS

Community Solutions is a one-year professional development program (four months of which are in the U.S.) for community leaders working in the fields of transparency and accountability, tolerance and conflict resolution, and women's issues.

ATLAS CORPS

The Atlas Corps Fellowship is a yearlong exchange giving business professionals the opportunity to increase their business acumen while serving in corporations, private companies, b-corps, and organizations in the U.S.

FORTUNE/U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT GLOBAL WOMEN'S MENTORING PARTNERSHIP

This public-private partnership provides mentoring for emerging women leaders from around the world by connecting them with mentors from Fortune's list of Most Powerful Women.

INTERNATIONAL WRITING PROGRAM FALL RESIDENCY

Writers in this ten week residency work on personal creative writing projects, give readings and lectures, and interact with American audiences and literary communities across the U.S.

MEPI - LEADERS FOR DEMOCRACY FELLOWS PROGRAM (LDF)

The LDF program provides emerging civic leaders and democracy activists the opportunity to spend 3 months in the U.S. or in Lebanon to gain academic skills and practical experience as well as to network with like-minded peers and professionals.
